- Reported that a letter was received from U.S.D.A. informing of selection for funding award of \$3,790,000 for future fire station and briefed on the application process.
- Announced that he will be attending the Fire District Associations conference.
- Reported that AMR is now providing ambulance services as of April 1, 2024.

Board members were given a written report from the Williams Fire Protection Authority Fire Suppression and Protection Services Assessment District Citizens' Oversight Committee. The committee consists of Evan Bell, Keenan Jorge and Gerry Nall. The committee recommended increasing the assessment rate by 3% for 2024-2025.
